**ADVISORY RELATED TO COVID-19**

In order to contain the spread of COVID-19, the following temporary measures are being put in place with regard to India:

**1) No scheduled International commercial passenger aircraft shall be allowed to land in India from 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2020 for one week.**

a) No taking off by any scheduled international commercial passenger aircraft at any foreign airport from 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2020 (0001 hrs GMT) till 29<sup>th</sup> March 2020 (0001 hrs GMT) at any airport in India.

b) No disembarkation of passengers by any scheduled international commercial passenger aircraft at any airport in India from 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2020 (2001 hrs GMT).
